WARNING

Blackpool Council and Blackpool Police have received complaints that you are acting in an anti-social manner. The complaints have included:

- Allowing individuals under 18 years of age to enter your property and consume alcohol and use illicit substances

Being satisfied that your conduct* is having a detrimental effect, of a persistent or continuing nature on the quality of life of those in the locality, and the conduct is unreasonable.

J Blackburn an authorised officer by **Blackpool Council** hereby requires you:

- **Not to engage or threaten to engage in any behaviour which may cause harassment, alarm or distress to any resident, visitor or worker in the locality**
- **Not to contact ***** either directly or through a third party, including but not limited to any form of social media, members of family or friends, phone calls, text or email**
- **Not to send any gifts to ***** , including but not limited to flowers, cards, letters and perfume**
- **Not to be in the presence of *******
- **Not to allow any female under the age of 18 years of age other than immediate family to enter your home address unless pre-arranged with Social Care on 01253 477261**
- **Not to be involved in the facilitation and consumption of alcohol and or illegal illicit substances to under 18 year olds**

This notice offers you the opportunity to avoid the issue of a Community Protection Notice.

* Note that 'Conduct' includes a failure to act -

* 'Conduct' on, or affecting, premises that a person owns, leases, occupies, controls, operates, or maintains, is treated as conduct of that person.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

A Community Protection Notice will be issued unless your conduct ceases to have the detrimental effect referred to above. Non-compliance with a Community Protection Notice carries criminal sanctions and can lead to a criminal record.

SERIAL NUMBER:

Failure to take all reasonable steps or failure without reasonable excuse to comply with a Community Protection Notice can lead to seizure and forfeiture of items, default works and recovery of costs and / or a fine of up to £2,500 in relation to an individual or up to £20,000 in the case of a body. Non-compliance may also result in the issue of a fixed penalty notice in the sum of £100.
